

## Manual CAT eduroam on Android

---

### Preparation

---

To set up eduroam on Android, the app eduroam CAT must be installed. You can download it from the PlayStore.

---

### Start the app and choose your university

---



Open the app eduroam CAT and select "Technische Universität Darmstadt".

If the location is not selected automatically, search for "Darmstadt" using the manual search.

If this does not work either, you have to visit the website "<https://cat.eduroam.org/?idp=5222>" with the internet browser of the device.

Download the configuration file there and open it with the eduroam CAT App.

## Verify data

---

Before the next step, the app may need to be allowed to access the local files. This is necessary to load the configuration file.

Now the configuration should be displayed in the app. If wrong data, e.g. the wrong university is displayed, please repeat the first step.

If the data is correct, continue by clicking on "Install".



---

## Enter your data

---

Now enter your data.

In the username field please enter only your login name (without any additions). In the password field enter your password.

Then click on "install". Now "Profile installed" should appear in green letters and the device should now be able to connect to eduroam.

If the installation fails, this may be due to an already installed configuration of eduroam. You have to remove this configuration first.

- To do this, go to the settings via the app menu.
- Then go to Network & Internet -> Wifi to display the available networks.
- Now click on "eduroam".
- Depending on your Android version, click on "remove" or "forget" in the drop-down or new window.
